The statement called Evangelicals & Catholics Together accelerated the quest for evangelical-Catholic detente in the mid-1990s. Many evangelicals seem to think this a positive, unifying movement. I'm convinced it is a dangerous drift. From the time I began to detect this new ecumenical climate until now, one of the few voices sounding a clear and consistent warning about it has always been R.C. Sproul's. He sees clearly that what is at stake is nothing less than the gospel. The various recent ecumenical manifestos all demonstrate this, albeit in subtle, confusing terms. More proof is found in the published teachings of the Roman Catholic Church herself. For at least fifteen years, I have wished for a clear, accessible expose using the most recent Roman Catholic catechism to show why that church's doctrine is incompatible with—even hostile to—the true gospel of Jesus Christ.
